

COVID – 19 Volunteer and Contractor Information and Agreement

This is to inform you of the new protocols connected to Covid-19 when coming into both the Downtown Detention Center and the County Jail.

- When in the jail you will always need to wear a mask. If you forget your mask or do not have one, we can provide one to you.
- During your class or service, you will need to practice social distancing guidelines for yourself and inmates to provide at least six feet of space between people.
- You will either wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before and after your class or service.
- You will complete temperature checks as directed by DSD staff and consent to the record retention of normal or elevated temperature readings.
- If you are experiencing a cough, fever, sore throat or any symptoms connected to the virus, **DO NOT** come into the jail and notify the Program Administrator.
- If you have tested positive for the COVID-19 you will need to have a subsequent negative test for COVID-19 or clearance from a doctor prior to entering the jails.

If you sign this form you are stating that you agree to all the new COVID- 19 protocols and expectations for entering the jails and have reviewed the COVID- 19 training.
